2nd Annual Poster Contest

Eligibility: All students in Pennsylvania, Delaware, and West Virginia including: public and private schools, home and cyber schools, and youth organizations

Details: The PSBR Poster Contest will have the following themes:

- Animal Research Saves Lives
- Animals Helping Animals
- Advancements in Biotechnology
- Careers in Science
- 3 R's: Replacement, Reduction, Refinement

Students are encouraged to illustrate their views on these themes.

The posters will be grouped in one of the following four grade categories - kindergarten through 3rd grade; 4th through 6th grade; 7th through 9th grade; and 10th through 12th grade.

Annual Essay Contests

Eligibility: All 7th-12th grade students in Pennsylvania, Delaware, and West Virginia including: public and private schools, home and cyber schools, and youth organizations.

Details: PSBR's Annual Essay Contest is divided into two separate contests – one for 7&8 graders AND one for high school students.

The contest recognizes students who demonstrate a superior understanding of bioscience research and the appropriate use of animals in biomedical research, and who can artfully communicate that understanding in writing.
